## OUR PROJECT

## Play to learn, learn to make your own way to success

During the school year, in Art and Technical Education classes, the pupils were making an ancient board game called Rota, brought to our territory by Roman soldiers about 2000 years ago. They used different materials in order to make both archaic and modern version of this ancient board game. In Art class, they used wood and clay for the archaic Rota whereas in Technical Education class, they made a modern electric Rota.



The creation and promotion of the aforementioned pupils' products were planned in cooperation with Zvonimir Cultural Institution and Solin Tourist Bord. The idea was to promote wooden and clay Rota as an authentic souvenir inspired by our historical and cultural background. Its electric version was also promoted as an innovative modern souvenir/board game which makes the best of both worlds, the Past and the Future in the Present. Since it is more appealing to younger generations, this product can be sold not only as a souvenir but a present, too.

In History class, the pupils learnt about historical aspects of entrepreneurship in ancient times. In Geography class, they were taught about some entrepreneurial aspects of tourism in the local community and different ways of tourist promotion. In Croatian class, they made some promotional materials (i.e. leaflets) related to Rota. Finally, in English class, the pupils translated them in English.
